REORGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL PRICE COORDINATING COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOLSONA, ILOCOS NORTE

WHEREAS, there is an existing Municipal Price Coordinating Council of Solsona, Ilocos Norte organized in accordance with existing laws, rules and regulations particularly DILG MC No. 2004-75 and Rule V of R.A. 7581 otherwise known as the Price Act;

WHEREAS, there is a need to re-organize the existing Municipal Price Coordinating Council of the municipality due to the change of local officials and employees as a result of the national and local elections last May 13, 2019;

NOW, THEREFORE, I JOSEPH E. DE LARA, Municipal Mayor of Solsona, Ilocos Norte by virtue of the powers and authority vested in me by law do hereby order:

Section 1. Composition of the Price Coordinating Council of Solsona, Ilocos Norte: The Council shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. Duties and Functions. The Municipal Price Coordinating Council shall have the following duties and functions:

1. Coordinate with government agencies and private organizations/institutions in monitoring prices of basic commodities in the municipality;
2. Conduct analysis of the causes of price fluctuations especially increase of prices of basic commodities and goods in the municipality;
3. Recommend to the higher local Price Coordinating Council especially the National Price Coordinating Council and concerned agencies Suggested Retail price (SRP) and/or allowable price ceilings of basic commodities in the municipality; and
4. Recommend possible actions/strategies to regulate unwarranted price increase and supply shortages and/or manipulations.

Section 3. Repeating Clause. All Executive Orders, Rules and Regulations and other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 13. Effectivity. This executive order shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
