EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 043 Series of 2019

REORGANIZING THE LOCAL POVERTY REDUCTION ACTION TEAM OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOLSONA, ILOCOS NORTE

WHEREAS, Republic Act 8425 or the Social Reform and Poverty Alleviation Act provides for the state's policy to adopt an area-based, sectoral and focused intervention to poverty alleviation wherein every Filipino Family shall be empowered to meet its minimum basic needs of health, food and nutrition, water and environmental sanitation, income security, shelter and decent housing, peace and order, education and functional literacy, participation in governance and family care and psycho-social integrity;

WHEREAS, Section 16, Book I, Title I of Republic Act No. 7160 also known as "An Act Providing for a Local Government Code of 1991" provides that; Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, the Department of Budget and Management (DBM), the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), and the National Anti-Poverty Commission (NAPC) issued a joint circular providing policy Guidelines and Procedures in the implementation of Bottom-Up Budgeting (BuB) for Budget Preparation;

WHEREAS, as a national strategy, the Human Development and Poverty Reduction Cluster (HDPRC) organized under Executive Order No. 43 series of 2011; together with the DBM and the DILG shall pilot the bottom-up approach in planning and budgeting and ensure the inclusion of the funding requirements for the development needs of at least 300 from the 609 selected focused local government units (LGUs) as identified and approved by the HDPRC in the budget proposals of participating national government agencies;

WHEREAS, there is a need to reorganize the Local Poverty Reduction Action Team of the Municipality of Solsona, Ilocos Norte due to the change of local officials as a result of the local and national election last May 13, 2019;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH E. DE LARA, Municipal Mayor, Solsona, Ilocos Norte by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby order the reorganization of the Local Poverty Reduction Action Team of the Municipality of Solsona, Ilocos Norte, to wit:

Section 1. Composition. The following shall compose the Local Poverty Reduction Action Team of the Municipality of Solsona, Ilocos Norte, to wit:

Section 2. Duties and Functions: The Local Poverty Reduction Action Team shall have the following duties and functions:

1. Shall spearhead the formulation and monitoring of the Local Poverty Reduction Action Plan;
2. Shall conduct a LPRAT workshop to formulate a Local Poverty Reduction Action Plan based on relevant economic and social data, as well as feedback from the members of the LPRAT;

3. Shall identify priority poverty reduction projects to be funded by the LGU and Projects which will be submitted to national agencies for consideration in their budget;
4. Shall ensure active participation of CSOs, basic sector representatives and other non-government stakeholders as they shall help validate data and analysis that will be presented by the LGU; and
5. Shall invite concerned Agency Regional Offices (AROs) to the workshop to provide information on the programs of their respective agencies and to provide technical assistance in the formulation of the LPRAT. The LPRAT shall identify a poverty reduction strategy to be undertaken by the LGU and other stakeholders.

Section 3. Composition of Technical Working Group (TWG). The Technical Working Group shall be composed of the following:

Section 4. Functions and Responsibilities of the TWG. The Technical Working Group shall have the following functions:

1. Formulate plans, programs, strategies and policies for poverty reduction;
2. Provide coordinate linkages with other agencies and institutions in the planning, monitoring and evaluation of plans for poverty alleviation; and
3. Establish and maintain database on poverty.

Section 4. Repealing Clause. Any law, orders and other administrative issuances inconsistent with this Executive order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 5. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
