ORGANIZING THE ROAD-CLEARING OPERATIONS TASK FORCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOLSONA, ILOCOS NORTE

WHEREAS, in his 4th State of the Nation Address, President R. Duterte directed the clearing of roads from illegal structures and constructions;

WHEREAS, in its Memorandum Circular No. 2019-121 dated July 29, 2019, the Department of the Interior and Local Government asserted the President's directing and enjoining all local officials to exercise their powers essential to reclaim public roads which are being used for private ends and in the process, rid them of illegal structures and constructions;

WHEREAS, Local Government Units are ordered to ensure immediate and effective implementation of road clearing operations pursuant to the said directives;

WHEREAS, there is a need to organize the Road-Clearing Operations Task Force of the Municipality of Solsona, Ilocos Norte to ensure immediate and effective implementation of road-clearing operations in the Municipality of Solsona, Ilocos Norte;

NOW THEREFORE, I Joseph E. de Lara, by the powers vested in me by law as the Municipal Mayor of Solsona, Ilocos Norte, do hereby organize the Road-Clearing Operations Task Force of the Municipality of Solsona, Ilocos Norte, as follows:

Section 1. Composition. The Road-Clearing Operations Task Force of Solsona, Ilocos Norte shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. Duties and Functions:

I. The RCO Task Force shall have the following duties and functions:

A. Executive Force:

1. To develop and implement strategies that will address the displacement issues caused by the implementation of the directive;
2. To ensure immediate and effective implementation of road clearing operations;
3. To exact accountability and impose corresponding sanctions, after observance of due process, against non-supportive and/or non-compliant local officials and employees;
4. To revoke permits that give authority to private entities to occupy public roads, alleys and other thoroughfares; and
5. Perform such other functions as maybe provided by law or component authority.

B. Legislative Force:

1. Enjoined to revisit ordinances and similar legislative measures to ensure responsiveness to this presidential directive and consistency with related laws and policies.

C. Primary Implementing Force:

1. Coordinate, collaborate and cooperate with the Local Government Unit of Solsona, Ilocos Norte for the implementation of the road-clearing operations;
2. Ensure achievement of significant results;
3. Submit results of action taken to the Local Government Unit; and
4. Perform all acts relative and necessary in carrying out the purpose of the Task Force.

D. Technical Working Group:

1. To cause rehabilitation of all recovered public roads by placing street names and street lights, among others;
2. Submit weekly progress report on the implementation of the road clearing operations to the Local Chief Executive; and
3. Perform such other functions as required by the RCOTF.

Section 3. Repealing Clause. All Executive Orders, Rules and Regulations and other Issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed and modified.

Section 4. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
