EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 057 Series of 2019

REORGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL COMMITTEE ON TUBERCULOSIS INFECTION CONTROL (MCTIC) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOLSONA, ILOCOS NORTE

WHEREAS, Tuberculosis is a disease caused by a bacterium called *Mycobacterium Tuberculosis* that is mainly acquired by inhalation of infectious droplets containing *tubercle bacilli*;

WHEREAS, infectious droplets can be produced by coughing, sneezing, talking and singing. Coughing is generally considered as the most efficient way of producing infectious droplets;

WHEREAS, the health hazards associated with tuberculosis may be minimized, if not totally eliminated by the different containment and control of levels and procedures observed in the laboratory and in the rural health center;

WHEREAS, most of the risks are associated with the bacilli nuclei spread and release into the environment;

WHEREAS, there is a need to constitute a body that shall undertake the study and evaluation of existing laws, policies and guidelines on the treatment, prevention and control of tuberculosis and its related matters, and recommend such measures for its effective utilization and prevention of possible pernicious effects to the health of the people, healthcare workers and the environment;

WHEREAS, there is a need to re-organize the MCTIC of the municipality due to the change of local officials brought about by the local and national elections last May 13, 2019;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH E. DE LARA, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Solsona, Ilocos Norte, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby re-organize the MCTIC.

Section 1. Re-organization and Composition. The Municipal Committee on Tuberculosis Infection Control shall be re-organized and composed of the following:

Section 2. Duties and Functions. The MCTIC of Solsona shall have the following duties and functions:

- a. Organize and strengthen a coordination body of TB infection control and develop a comprehensive plan that includes human resource requirements, policies and procedures for implementation of TB infection control at all levels;
- b. Ensure the health facility design, construction, renovation and use are properly functioning;
- c. Conduct surveillance of TB disease among health workers and conduct assessment at all levels of the health system especially in congested settings;
- d. Address TB infection control advocacy, communication and social mobilization (ACSM), including engagement of civil society, NGOs and private sectors;
- e. Monitor and evaluate the set of TB infection control measures; and
- f. Conduct operational research and monitor the effectiveness and efficiency of the TB Infection Control in the Municipality.

Section 3. Funding. Funding and requirements for the expenses to be incurred in the furtherance of its function shall come from the Solsona Rural Health Unit under their Maintenance and other Operating Expenses (MOOE).

The Municipal Health Office shall allocate from its present budget such amount as may be necessary for the initial operation of the Solsona MCTIC and its secretariat. Thereafter, the funding requirements shall be included in the annual budget.

Section 4. Secretariat. The Rural Sanitary Inspector and the MDRRMO of the Municipality shall be the Secretariat of the MCTIC, with the member agencies providing additional staff support as the need arises.

Section 5. Repealing Clause. All orders issuances which are inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified.

Section 4. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately after its approval.
