**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO.** 83

Series of 2020

**AN ORDER DECLARING LOCKDOWN AND CONTAINMENT OF CERTAIN AREAS OF SITIOS 4, 5, 6 AND 7 BARANGAY BAGBAGO, SOLSONA, ILOCOS NORTE**

**WHEREAS**, one of the declared policies under the 1987 Constitution is to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 90-20 of the Provincial Governor authorizes the imposition of localized lockdown for the purpose of contract tracing;

**WHEREAS**, one of the residents of Sitio 4 Buangga, Barangay Bagbago, Solsona, Ilocos Norte is a confirmed CoViD-19 patient (IN-C106);

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to impose localized lockdown of certain areas of Sitio 4 of Barangay Bagbago for contract tracing purposes and for the abatement of further transmission;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH E. DE LARA**, Mayor of Municipality of Solsona, Ilocos Norte by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

**SECTION 1. LOCKDOWN AND CONTAINMENT OF SITIO 4, 5, 6, AND 7, BARANGAY BAGBAGO, SOLSONA, ILOCOS NORTE COVERING A RADIUS OF ONE THOUSAND (1000) METERS.**

1. All ingress and egress roads going in and out of said area shall be closed and barricaded (movable) by the Philippine National Police in collaboration with the Barangay Officials. Checkpoints shall be established by Barangay Laureta, Santiago and Bagbago in major ingress and egress supervised by the Philippine National Police to ensure that there will be no unnecessary entry of people, non-residents and their vehicle coming from outside the affected areas and there shall be strictly NO EXIT of residents of the covered area, except the following:
  - a. Health workers residing within the 1000-meter radius;
  - b. Officers of the PNP, AFP, and government workers rendering emergency frontline service;

- c. Service workers who are working in pharmacies, drug stores and death care services;
- d. Officers of the Barangay;
- e. Workers in media duly accredited by the PCOO and IATF.

The above-mentioned exempt individuals shall strictly follow minimum health standards at all times such as but not limited to wearing of facemasks, faceshields and regular handwashing.

2. **STRICT STAY HOME ORDER.** Subject to exemption provided herein, no one in the whole households shall be allowed to go out of the house and loiter on the roads. No children playing outside and mingling with the neighbor's children.
3. **COMPLETELY NO MASS GATHERING WILL BE ALLOWED.** No parties, birthday celebrations with invited guests and no religious and traditional services which entail the physical gathering of the people from two (2) or more households.
4. **ACCESS TO ESSENTIAL NEEDS.** Access to essential needs must be arranged by alternative means by requesting the Punong Barangay, Kagawad or other Barangay Officials in the different strategic checkpoints to purchase supplies on their behalf and to be delivered to the requesting household.

**SECTION 2. PENALTIES.** Any violation of this Order shall make the person loable amd shall be duly charged for non-cooperation under RA 11332 and other pertinent law, rules and regulations, and ordinances.

**SECTION 3. ENFORCEMENT.** All Barangay Officials, the Municipal Police Station and other duly delegated local enforcers are hereby mandated to ensure compliance to the full extent and execution of this order.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY.** – This Order shall take effect immediately.

**SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE.** – All orders inconsistent to this is hereby amended, revoked, and repealed accordingly.
