MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 118

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE POSTAL CORPORATION IN
THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOLSONA TO PAY THEIR RENTALS
AND BILLS AMOUNTING TO FOUR HUNDRED PESOS (P400.00)
PER MONTH FOR THE SPACE BEING OCCUPIED BY THEIR
OFFICE WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING OF SOLSONA,
ILOCOS NORTE, RETROACTIVE SEPTEMBER 1993.

WHEREAS, the Postal Corporation is presently occu-
pying a space owned by the Municipal Government of Solsona,
Ilocos Norte;

WHEREAS, the Bills (electric Bills) of the said
corporation is being shouldered by the Municipal Government
where Revenue Allotment is not even enough to carry-out
its developmental programs;

WHEREAS, Article 100 (a) (2) (ii) to wit: subject
to the Provisions of Book II of the Code and applicable laws
and upon the majority vote of all the members of the Sang-
guniang Bayan, enact Ordinances levying taxes, fees and
charges prescribing the rates thereof for general and spe-
cific purposes;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan knows fully well
that the Postal Corporation had already been privatized;

WHEREFORE, by virtue of the power vested upon the
Sangguniang Bayan and pursuant to the aforementioned provisions
of the Code and upon motion of Hon. Gervacio B. Vicente, duly
seconded by Hon. Rogerio E. Teodoro, be it

ORDAINED, that

Section 1 - The Postal Corporation is required to
pay their rentals and bills amounting to FOUR HUNDRED PESOS
(P400.00) per month;

Section 2 - The rentals and bills for the preceding
year should be paid to the Municipal Treasurer every January;
