MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 276

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING FEE ON THE REGISTRATION OF LEGAL INSTRUMENTS AND COURT DECREES AT THE OFFICE OF THE MUNICIPAL CIVIL REGISTRAR AND PROVIDING PENALTIES IN VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, it is mandated under Sec. 129 of the Local Government Code of 1991 that Municipalities are now empowered to create sources of revenues;

WHEREAS, Administrative Order No. 01 series of 1993, Rule 7 (2) and (3) implementing Rules and Regulations of Act No. 3753 and other laws on Civil Registration states that: every civil registrar shall maintain, keep and preserve in a secured place in his office the following registry books where he shall properly enter the acts, events and judicial decrees concerning the civil status of persons;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Rogerio E. Teodoro, unanimously seconded and by virtue of the power vested upon the Sangguniang Bayan, be it ORDAINED, that

Section 1 - The amount of THIRTY PESOS (P30.00) as a Registration Fee of legal instruments and court decrees is hereby imposed;

Section 2 - This amount shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer or her authorized representative before it shall be recorded in the Register of Court Decrees/Orders or legal Instruments;

Section 3 - The successful petitioner shall within ten (10) days after the decree/order has become final, report said decree/order in the civil registrar's office concerned;

Section 4 - Any person who shall knowingly make false statements in the forms furnished and shall present the same for entry in the civil registry shall be punished by a fine of not less than TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P200.00) or imprisonment of not less than one month but not more than six months or both at the discretion of the Court;

Section 5 - Late registration shall be subject to a 25% surcharge for the first 30 days and 50% surcharge for 31 days or more;

Section 6 - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after 21 days of posting in conspicuous places and after publication in a newspaper of local circulation;

Copies of this Ordinance be furnished the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Laoag City and Miss Luida P. Blanco, Provincial Statistics Officer, Laoag City, for their information and consideration;




