MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 54

AN ORDINANCE PROMOTING AN EFFICIENT FISCAL MANAGEMENT BY AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR/PRESIDING OFFICER OF THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN TO UTILIZE SAVINGS IN THEIR RESPECTIVE OFFICES BY WAY OF TRANSFER TO OTHER ITEMS WITHIN THE SAME EXPENSE CLASS IN THEIR RESPECTIVE APPROPRIATION;

WHEREAS, one of the objectives of the Municipal Government is the efficient, effective and immediate delivery of basic services and facilities to all constituents;

WHEREAS, pursuant to this objective, there is a need to adopt measures that will contribute in the efficient fiscal management of the Municipal Government especially in the Office of the Mayor and Office of the Sangguniang Bayan;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Mayor or the Presiding Officer of the Sangguniang Bayan, may, by Ordinance, be authorized to augment any item in the approved annual budget for their respective Offices from savings in other items with same expense class of their respective appropriations (Sec. 336, RA 7160);

WHEREFORE, by virtue of the Legislative Power vested in the Sangguniang Bayan and pursuant to Section 336 of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Bayan hereby ordains that;

Section I. Definition of Terms. The terms savings and augmentation as used in this ordinance shall mean;

- 1. Savings refers to portions or balance of any programmed appropriations free from any obligations or encumbrance which is still available after the satisfactory completion or unavoidable discontinuance or abandonment of the work activity or purpose for which the appropriation is authorized or arising from unpaid compensation and related costs pertaining to vacant positions.

ARTICLE 2. Augmentation implies the existence in the budget of an item, project, activity or purpose with an appropriation which upon implementation or subsequent evaluation of needed resources is determined to be deficient.

Section 2. Delegation of authority to the Municipal Mayor and Vice-Mayor to augment funds. The Municipal Mayor or the Presiding Officer of the Sangguniang Bayan are hereby authorized to augment any time in the approved budget (annual) of the Municipality for their respective offices from savings in other items within the same expense class of their respective appropriations, provided that, the availability of savings for the above purpose is certified in writing and under oath by the Municipal Treasurer. Provided further, that the exercise of the power delegated shall be subject to the limitations and restrictions provided in title V, Book II of the Local Government Code of 1991.

Section 3. Manner of the exercising power. The Municipal Mayor and the Presiding Officer of the Sangguniang Bayan may exercise the authority granted in the preceding sections by the issuance of an Executive Order or any other forms of communication expressing the same, duly signed and stating with sufficient particularity the item to be augmented and the sources from which the funds is to be taken.

Section 4. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval. Luis B. Ganal, duly seconded by Hon. Henry A. Batara, be it

Section 1 - Imposition of Fees - Parking fees are hereby imposed on all animal drawn and motorized vehicles parked on all roads authorized as parking areas within one hundred (100) meters radius of the Solsona Public Market, as follows:

On motion of Member Henry A. Batara, duly seconded by Member Teodoro, this Ordinance was unanimously approved.

Copies of this Ordinance be furnished to Hon. Nestor Corpuz Chairman, Committee on Appropriation and the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, the Provincial Budget Officer, Laong City, the Municipal Budget Officer and the Municipal Treasurer, Solsona, Ilocos Norte, for their information and consideration.

Section 2 - Time of Payment - The fees imposed herein shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer or his duly authorized representative upon parking.
