MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2005-549

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL PHILHEALTH MEMBERS AND THE MEMBERS OF THEIR FAMILIES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOLSONA TO PLANT MALUNGGAY, KATURAY, KAMOTE AND OTHER GREEN LEAFY VEGETABLES AS A REQUISITE TO THEIR CONTINUED MEMBERSHIP IN THE PHILIPPINE HEALTH INSURANCE SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, most members of the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PHIC) belong to the lower economic class of the community, the main reason for the existence of the health insurance system being that indigents must have easy access to medical care;

WHEREAS, to ensure for the continuous access to medical care through their membership in the Philippine Health Insurance System and to ensure that they have free and continuous supply of protein-rich foods and vegetables, these PHILHEALTH members are required to plant malunggay, katuray, kamote and other green leafy vegetables;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Lucky S. Sanchez, duly seconded by all members present, be it

ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Solsona, Ilocos Norte, that:

Section 1 - All Philhealth members in the Municipality of Solsona of good standing, including the members of their families, are hereby required to plant malunggay, katuray, camote and other green leafy vegetables in their homelots and backyards as a requisite to their continued membership in the Philippine Health Insurance System;

Section 2 - The Local Chief Executive, through the Executive Department's personnel involved in the National Nutrition Program, primarily the Municipal Agricultural Officer and the Municipal Nutrition Action Officer, together with the Barangay Nutrition Scholars and Barangay Health Workers, shall be responsible in overseeing the implementation of the provisions of this Ordinance;

Section 3 - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval;


Copies of this Ordinance be furnished the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Laoag City and all others concerned, for their information and consideration;
