MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 56

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY PESOS (P30.00)  
AS MAYOR'S PERMIT FEE ON BUSINESS.

WHEREAS, Section 36 of the Philippine Law on Local Taxation states that the Local Government Unit may collect a fee sufficient to cover the cost of regulation, inspection and surveillance relative to the issuance of a permit which shall be required of an individual or any juridical entity before the same shall engage in any business on occupation;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Units are authorized to impose "Mayor's Permit Fees" under Section 36, the code does not fix any rate;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Rogerio E. Teodoro, duly seconded by Hon. Ismael Agulay and Hon. Jovencio Pascua, be it

ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Solsona, Ilocos Norte, that:

Section 1 - Imposition of Fee- There shall be collected an annual fee at a rate of THIRTY PESOS (P30.00) for the issuance of a Mayor's Permit to every person that shall conduct a business, trade or activity within the Municipality of Solsona;

The Mayor's Permit fee is payable for every separate or distinct establishment or place where the business trade or activity is conducted. One line of business or activity does not become exempt by being business or activity for which the permit fee has been paid;

Section 2 - Time of Payment - The fee imposed in the preceding section shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer upon application for a Mayor's Permit before any business or activity can be lawfully begun or pursued and within the first twenty (20) days of January of each year in case of renewal thereof;

Section 3 - Surcharge for late payment -  
Failure to pay the amount prescribed fee shall subject the taxpayer to a surcharge of twenty-five (25%) percent of the original amount of tax due, such surcharge to be paid at the same time and in the same manner as the tax due;

Section 4 - This Ordinance shall take effect after the lapse of ten (10) days from the day a copy of it is posted in the municipal Hall, public market and other conspicuous places and upon publication in a newspaper as required by law;


