MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 57

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PERSON OR PERSONS FROM ENTERING
INSIDE THE PUBLIC MARKET COMPOUND BETWEEN 8:00 O'CLOCK IN
THE EVENING UP TO 4:00 O'CLOCK IN THE MORNING.

WHEREAS, the municipal properties inside the public
market are often destroyed or stolen;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Antonio D. Refani,
duly seconded by Hon. Rogeric E. Teodoro and Hon. Agripino
Estavillo, be it

ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Solsona,
Ilocos Norte, that:

Section 1 - Any person/persons are prohibited from
roaming around or entering inside the market compound
between 8:00 o'clock in the evening and 4:00 o'clock in
the morning;

Section 2 - Any person/persons caught roaming
inside the public market compound between 8:00 o'clock in
the evening up to 4:00 o'clock in the morning shall be
fine of not less than FIFTY PESOS (P50.00) but not excee-
ding ONE HUNDRED PESOS (P100.00) or imprisonment of not
less than FIVE (5) days but not exceeding TEN (10) days or
both.

Section 3 - This Ordinance shall take effect after
the lapse of THIRTY (30) days from the day a copy of it is
publicized in the newspaper of the general circulation and
posted in the municipal hall and other conspicuous places.

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 34

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY (30) PESOS AS MAYOR'S PERMIT FEE ON BUSINESS. Municipal Mayor

WHEREAS, section 36 of the Philippine Law on Local Taxation states that the Local Government Unit may collect a fee sufficient to cover the cost of regulation, inspection and surveillance relative to the issuance of a permit which shall be required of an individual or any juridical entity before the same shall engage in any business or occupation;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Units are authorized to impose "Mayor's Permit Fees" under section 36, the code does not fix any rate;

WHEREAS, on motion of Hon. Rogerio M. Teodoro, duly seconded by Hon. Ismael Aguilay and Hon. Jovencio Pascua, be it

ORDERED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bolsona, Ilocos Norte, that:

Section 1 - Imposition of Fee- There shall be collected an annual fee at a rate of TWENTY PESOS (20.00) for the issuance of a Mayor's Permit to every person that shall conduct a business, trade or activity within the municipality of Bolsona;

The Mayor's Permit fee is payable for every separate or distinct establishment or place where the business, trade or activity is conducted. One line of business or activity does not become exempt by using business or activity for which the permit fee has been paid;

Section 2 - Time of Payment - The fee imposed in the preceding section shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer upon application for a Mayor's Permit before any business or activity can be lawfully begun or pursued and within the first twenty (20) days of January of each year in case of renewal thereof;
