MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2008- 572

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALAKNIB TASKFORCE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOLSONA, ILOCOS NORTE TO ENFORCE PROVISIONS OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES AND OTHER NATIONAL AND LOCAL LAWS AND RULES AND DEFINING THEIR DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS.


On motion of Hon. Ismael L. Agulay, unanimously seconded by all the members present, be it

ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Solsona, Ilocos Norte in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. – SHORT TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known as “AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALAKNIB TASKFORCE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOLSONA, ILOCOS NORTE”.

SECTION 2. – DEFINITION OF TERMS. –

1. **ORGANIZED GROUP/NON-GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION** – refers to an association, organization or union composed of a group of competent individuals duly organized and accredited by the government;
2. **BARANGAY TANOD** – refers to Barangay Police now being maintained in all barangays that assists in law enforcement in the community;
3. **DEPUTIZED OFFICER** – individuals holding positions in government or private entities or non government associations, they are authorized to render service clothed with certain powers stated in this ordinance;
4. **CITATION TICKET** – a ticket used primarily by the Local Government Unit of Solsona that indicates the nature and kind of violation committed by an individual also indicating therein the amount of penalty or fine.
5. **EX-OFFICIO OFFICERS** – by virtue of their office, they become as such in this group.



6. SALAKNIB TASKFORCE – refers to a group of individuals especially organized under this Ordinance to strictly enforce all Ordinances of the municipality and other laws, rules and regulations that concerns peacefulness, cleanliness and protection of the environment.

SECTION 3. – OBJECTIVES.

The main objective of this ordinance is to organize and make functional, a special body in the municipality that will closely monitor and watch on the implementation of Ordinances, rules and regulations relating to peace and order and environment protection.

This Ordinance shall enable all sectors of the society to group together that may be called as “SALAKNIB TASKFORCE” which may turn into a crusade for peacefulness, orderliness and cleanliness in the municipality.

SECTION 4. – COMPOSITION OF THE SALAKNIB TASK FORCE. The group herein created to be called “Salaknib Taskforce in the Municipality of Solsona” shall be composed of the following, viz:

4.1. EX-OFFICIO OFFICERS:

4.1.1. CHAIRMAN – THE MUNICIPAL MAYOR;

4.1.2. TWO (2) VICE CHAIRMAN:

THE MUNICIPAL VICE MAYOR
THE PNP CHIEF OF POLICE

4.1.3. SEVEN (7) STAFF OFFICERS.

SB MEMBER, Chairman, Committee on Peace and Order;
SB MEMBER, Chairman, Committee on Environment;
SB Member, Chairman, Committee on Public Utility
Municipal Treasurer;
Chief Fire Department;
One (1) PNP Personnel;
Legal Officer/ Municipal Administrator.

4.2. DEPUTIZED OFFICERS:

BARANGAY TANODS – All barangay tanods from the twenty-two (22) barangays qualified based on the standards set by the ex-officio officers;



ELECTED BARANGAY OFFICIALS - All Barangay Kagawads including the SK Chairman, with the Punong Barangay as their coordinator;

PNP/ FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL – Any PNP and Fire Department Personnel shall be assigned by their respective heads congruent to their office schedules and assigned tasks;

NON GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATIONS – Any NGO duly organized, recognized and accredited by the Local Government of Solsona can be deputized by the Chairman of the Salaknib Taskforce as enforcers under this ordinance.

SECTION 5. – FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICERS, PERSONNEL AND MEMBERS.

THE CHAIRMAN – He shall exercise overall administration, supervision and coordination of all personnel and members mentioned in Section 4 of this Ordinance;



The Chairman shall lead the taskforce in the formulation of plans and programs as well as the day to day activities of the various groups. For this purpose, there shall be a monthly caucus of the staff and heads of the organized groups.

THE VICE CHAIRMAN – Responsible in the implementation of the plans and programs in their respective jurisdiction and shall see into the strict implementation of the penalties on violators.

THE STAFF OFFICERS – Shall attend to recording and documentation of activities and accomplishments of the entire program of the taskforce and report the same to the Chairman during the regular monthly caucus.

The time devoted herein by the staff officers shall be predetermined with their immediate superiors to avoid conflicts with their regular office duties and functions.

APPREHENDING PERSONNEL/OFFICERS – the time devoted to apprehend violators of the Local Ordinances, Laws, Rules and Regulations shall be based on the schedule of their official time prepared and approved by the immediate head/supervisor. They are required to take frequent orientation on such provisions of laws thru the supervision of the Chairman and Vice Chairman. All apprehensions must be recorded and brought to the attention of the Chairman and Vice Chairman thru the Staff Officers. Citation tickets issued to offenders must be forwarded to the office of the Legal Officer/Administrator for filing at the Prosecutor's Office if they need legal action in court.

BARANGAY TANODS AND MEMBERS OF NON-GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATIONS – with the consent and coordination of their respective heads, shall render service to the activities of the Salaknib Taskforce congruent to the plans and programs, but such area of jurisdiction is limited only to the territory designated to them by the Chairman of the "Salaknib Taskforce". They should familiarize themselves with the ordinances, laws, rules and regulations and should attend regular briefing called by the chairman of the "Salaknib Taskforce" or his duly authorized representative however their attendance herein should always be with permission of their respective superiors.

All apprehensions made by the Barangay Tanods or any individual emanating from any of the recognized non-government organizations on enforcement of ordinances, laws, rules and regulations with the use of citation ticket should be reported in accordance with the standard procedure set by the Chairman of the "Salaknib Taskforce".

The Barangay Officials shall work hand in hand with the other deputized officers working for the same purpose and together with them make the necessary monthly report to the "Salaknib Taskforce" and at any time issue citation ticket when necessary. They may render service to the activities of the "Salaknib Taskforce" anytime of the day but limited only to the territorial jurisdiction of their barangay.

All PNP Personnel and Fire Department Personnel designated herein by their respective chief shall render service to the "Salaknib Taskforce" in a manner as maybe needed by the situation. They will be fielded to a definite territory in the municipality to assist the personnel above enumerated in the enforcement of ordinances, laws, rules and regulations especially in the apprehension of violators and issuance of citation tickets.

SECTION 7. – ISSUANCE OF CITATION TICKETS.

This ordinance authorizes all the enforcement personnel from the apprehending officers to the deputized personnel to issue citation tickets entrusted to them.

The apprehending officers shall sign the citation ticket and issue the same to the violator of a certain ordinance indicating therein the violation and penalty being imposed. The same shall be countersigned by the Police Officer accompanying the apprehending personnel if any or if not present it may be done upon submission of such ticket to the Secretariat of the Salaknib Taskforce.

The citation tickets issued shall serve as evidence and reference in the prosecution of the violations when such are brought to court as well as basis in the report of fees collected by the "Salaknib Taskforce" program.

SECTION 8. – PENALTIES.

This Ordinance adopts the penalties imposed upon in Municipal Ordinances already passed and approved by the Sangguniang Bayan including Ordinances to be passed after approval hereof shall be adopted.

All penalties to be collected to the violators shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer.

Such amounts collected shall accrue to the general fund of the municipality which upon approval of the Local Chief Executive maybe allocated later for expenses of the "Salaknib Taskforce" programs and activities.

SECTION 9. - INCENTIVE TO DEPUTIZED APPREHENDING PERSONNEL. -

All apprehending personnel of the "Salaknib Taskforce" deputized to implement Municipal Ordinances and other local rules, laws and regulations shall be given incentive for their services as such "enforcers" corresponding to thirty percent (30%) of the total fines and penalties imposed upon and collected from the violators he/she has actually apprehended.

The incentive to be granted will be collected from the Office of the Municipal Treasurer after every fifteenth and thirtieth day of the month after the Enforcers through the Vice Chairman of the "Salaknib Taskforce" has submitted all reports on apprehension/s to the Chairman of the "Salaknib Taskforce" for confirmation on the grant of said incentive.

SECTION 10. - REPEALING OR AMENDATORY CLAUSE. - Any provisions of existing ordinances, rules and regulations and or parts thereof inconsistent to the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed and or modified accordingly.


SECTION 11. - EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and the posting thereof at the Municipal Hall and at every Barangay Hall in the Municipality of Solsona for a period of ten (10) days.

Copies of this Municipal Ordinance be forwarded to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Provincial Capitol, Laoag City for their review and other offices and authorities concern for their information, favorable and appropriate action.




