**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2009-579**

**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE BOOK ENTITLED "SOLSONA – OUR HOME, OUR PRIDE, OUR TREASURE" AS THE CENTENNIAL BOOK OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SOLSONA, ILOCOS NORTE.**

**WHEREAS**, the municipality of Solsona, Ilocos Norte was formerly named SANTIAGO which was cited as an ecclesiastical annex of the Pueblo (town) of Piddig, Ilocos Norte in 1851;

**WHEREAS**, from 1903 to 1909, Solsona was annexed to the Municipality of Dingras, Ilocos Norte but was reconstituted/reestablished as a Municipality by virtue of an Executive Order No. 135 dated December 21, 1909 issued by the then U.S. Governor General William Cameron Forbes;

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 135 came into effect January 1, 1910 thus Year 2010 was declared by the President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo as the Centennial Year of the reconstitution of the Municipality of Solsona, Ilocos Norte through Presidential Proclamation No. 1960;

**WHEREAS**, one of the significant activity during the month long centennial celebration is the launching and publication of the book entitled "Solsona, Our Home, Our Pride, Our Treasure";

**WHEREAS**, the book embodies the rich history and culture of the municipality and its people, the best heritage that every Solsonian is proud of;

**WHEREFORE**, upon motion of Hon. Jose A. Martin, unanimously seconded, be it

**ORDAINED**, by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled, that:

**Section 1** – the book entitled "Solsona, our home, our pride, our treasure" is hereby declared as the Centennial Book of the municipality of Solsona, Ilocos Norte;

**Section 2** – all the barangays of the municipality shall have at least one (1) copy each per Barangay to be kept at the Barangay Hall and to be made always available to the residents therein for reading and reference;

**Section 3** – all the schools of Solsona, Ilocos Norte at the elementary and secondary levels both private and public, are hereby encouraged to teach to the pupils and students, the history of the

municipality, which is the main feature of the book upon prior approval by the Department of Education;

**Section 4** – the author/publisher of the book shall cause the printing of sufficient copies available for sale to the public at a reasonable price;

**Section 5** – reproduction of the book or any portion thereof shall be prohibited without the permission of the author/publisher;

**Section 6** – this Municipal Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and compliance of the requirements as provided in the Local Government Code;






