**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-092**

**GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE, HON. JOSEPH E. DE LARA, TO EXTEND PAYMENT HOLIDAY TO STALL LESSEES IN THE SOLSONA PUBLIC MARKET DUE TO THE PANDEMIC BROUGHT ABOUT BY COVID-19.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of the Local Government Code provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

**WHEREAS**, COVID-19 has brought extensive alarm and concern not only to the Municipality of Solsona, Ilocos Norte due to the pandemic brought about by the dreadful COVID-19;

**WHEREAS**, the transmission of the dreaded disease is so loose, that even the developed countries are now suffering from chaos, fear and panic, and worst causing death to those infected with the anxious virus;

**WHEREAS**, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte declared a state of calamity throughout the Philippines due to corona virus disease 2019;

**WHEREAS**, consonant to such directive from Malacañang Palace, the Governor of the Province of Ilocos Norte Hon. J. Matthew Marcos Manotoc issued Executive Order 60-20 series of 2020 placing the Province of Ilocos Norte under "community quarantine" to prevent the possible spread of COVID-19 in the locality;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Solsona, Ilocos Norte issued Temporary Suspension of Business Operations to all business establishments that fall under non-essential entities and there are also business establishments who are allowed to operate with limited operating hours in compliance to national and local directives;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. Benigno L. Aquino, unanimously seconded by all the members present, it was;


